

The FRIENDS of the Sherborn Council on Aging Student Service Award

Purpose: The Friends of the Sherborn Council on Aging student service award publicly recognizes a student, or student group, who has participated in individual or community services related to Sherborn senior citizens and/or the programs of the Sherborn Council on Aging. This award is designed to foster intergenerational relationships, promote community service serving Sherborn seniors, enhance the lives of Sherborn's seniors, and to encourage and reward students for outstanding service outside of the basic service hours necessary for graduation.

Description of Award: \$500 monetary award and commemorative engraved plaque

Primary Criterion: The primary criterion is significant, documented involvement in, or service to, a program involving Sherborn senior citizens. Consideration will be given to the nature and extent of this activity and to the value of the service to the community or individual.

Eligibility: The applicants, or nominated parties, should be students at Dover Sherborn High School, and meet the criteria described above for applying. Applicants may be underclass and/or senior students. Primary consideration will be given to Sherborn residents.

Application Procedure: We encourage individuals or groups who have been served by an eligible student(s) to nominate a candidate by letter, describing the nature of service. No application is necessary if the student is nominated by an individual or organization. If the applicant wishes to apply directly on their own, applications are available at the Dover Sherborn High School Guidance office.
