Establishing a North Sherborn Water and Sewer District

North Sherborn Water & Sewer District Q & A Sessions

You're invited to attend one of two scheduled Q & A sessions regarding the establishment of a water and sewer district, which will be voted on at the Special Town Meeting on October 17, 2023. The Town Administrator, well-informed Sherborn citizens, and representatives from the North Sherborn Water and Sewer District, will be on hand to answer any and all of your questions.

When established, it will allow Framingham's MWRA water and sewer pipes to be extended into Sherborn to provide water and sewer infrastructure to two housing projects on Coolidge Street that the Town has already approved. These projects will place the Town in compliance with the State Chapter 40B law that requires all towns to provide at least 10% affordable housing, and will provide a diversity of housing options, a major goal of Sherborn's Master Plan and Housing Production Plan.
